The following Import Permit, when completed and signed by the owner and the State Veterinarians of California and Colorado, will allow for the importation of beef feeder cattle without a caudal fold tuberculosis test.

All feeder cattle imported MUST BE ACCOMPANIED by a **Certificate of Veterinary Inspection** and a **Brand Inspection Certificate** issued prior to movement and a copy of this TB Test Exemption Import Permit. The above permit CACO2K9-XX number will serve as the owner’s import permit number and is to be written on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection.

SECTION II – Please read carefully and sign below

1. All imported feeder cattle shall originate from an area of California that is not epidemiologically or geographically linked to a TB investigation. Cattle commingled with Mexican steers while in California will be required to be TB test negative.
2. The California and the Colorado facilities shall be required to obtain a NAIS Premises Identification Number and the PIN shall be listed on this import permit.
3. All imported feeder cattle shall be individually identified with an official eartag that links to the state of origin and is approved by the Colorado state veterinarian.
4. All imported feeder cattle must be inspected by a California brand inspector at the premises of origin. The Brand Inspection Certificate, a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection and a copy of this California TB Test Exemption Permit shall accompany the movement to Colorado. The cattle covered by this permit may be inspected by the Colorado Department of Agriculture upon arrival in Colorado.
5. The imported feeder cattle shall not commingle (occupy common grazing enclosures) with Colorado breeding cattle at any time while in Colorado.
6. All imported feeder cattle shall be brand inspected by a Colorado brand inspector when leaving the Colorado premises listed on this permit and shall remain in slaughter channels.
7. Non-compliance with this permit may result in corrective actions or TB testing of cattle imported on this permit.
